







Place these items in front of your child asking them what they are to ensure they know the names of the items. Then ask them to place one of the smaller item in a particular place on the larger pictures. The number of information carrying words (ICW) used varies with how many aspects the child needs to attend to. e.g. Put this on a rock = 1 ICW Put the mouse on a rock = 2 ICW, put the big mouse on a rock = 3 ICW, put the big mouse on the little rock = 4 ICW, put the big mouse and a frog on the big rock = 5 ICW and put the big mouse on the big rock and the little fly on the big tree = 8 ICW. You may need to show your child what to do many times to help them be successful. Your speech pathologist can show you how to do this if you are unsure.
